








Legion Breakfast & New Member Orientation

During the Covid-19 Crisis, it is requested that guests not be invited to come with a member to the Lodge





Every active member of the Loyal Order of Moose and Women of the Moose have the opportunity to participate and your points are rewarded automatically. There is no paperwork or submissions required.




